No person or organization has been authorized to solicit or conduct interviews in conjunction with the proposed Toledo medical college, Dr. Frank F. A. Rawling, president of the Toledo Area Medical College and Education Foundation, said today.

Three Toledo nurses reported today that they had been contacted by a man, about 30 years of age, who said he was conducting a series of interviews with graduate nurses in connection with the proposed new medical school.

If and when the foundation decides to launch any public campaign, which Dr. Rawlings does not foresee, authorized persons and organizations will be supplied with adequate credentials, he said.
