An estimated 5,600 students -- nearly 1,000 of them freshmen -- will begin classes at the University of Toledo Monday, (Sept. 15). Preliminary registration figures released by Mrs. Alina Markowski, registrar, Friday show an increase of nearly 300 over last year's figure for the same day. The total figure Friday was 5,571; this breaks down to 3,119 day students and 2,452 enrolled in evening sessions. The total is expected to be considerably larger when the final figures are compiled after late registration.

Freshman students will have a week of college life behind them Monday. They were on campus every day this week for Freshman Week activities and some 200 of them will return late tomorrow afternoon (Sunday) from Freshman Camp at Camp Storer, Michigan.

Also returning from camp with the freshmen will be TU President William S. Carlson who is spending part of the weekend with the new students. Dr. Carlson has devoted most of his first two weeks in office to getting acquainted with the university, its faculty and the students.

He will be the guest of the Varsity T Club Monday at a party for university athletes. During this week's activities for the new students he was a guest and speaker at the Inter Fraternity Council smoker for freshmen and he and Mrs. Carlson were hosts to the freshmen and their parents at a reception Sunday, (Sept. 7).

In addition to classes, campus activities also get into full swing next week. The first issue of the Campus Collegian, student newspaper, is scheduled for Friday and a dance for all students and their guests is set for Friday evening. The football season opens Saturday (Sept. 20) with a home game with Eastern Kentucky in the Glass Bowl at 8:15 p.m.
