The 500th University of Toledo ROTC cadet will receive his commission as an Army Second Lieutenant on Thursday (July 30) at 10 a.m. in the office of Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president.

Colonel Arthur J. DeLuca, commander of TU's ROTC detachment, will award the 500th commission to Robert S. Hardy, Jr., 322 Crittenden St. He is a 1958 graduate of Toledo Central Catholic High School. Cadet Hardy is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert S. Hardy, Sr., 1836 Wyndhurst Dr.

Cadet Hardy will begin active duty on August 27 with the Artillery.

Also to be commissioned on Thursday is David S. Hardin, 2256 Glenwood Ave. He is a graduate of Scott High School and plans to work toward a masters degree at TU during the next year. He will enter active duty with the Ordnance Corps in July, 1965.

The first cadet commissioned through TU's Army ROTC program was Robert F. Beltz, who received his commission on June 16, 1949.
