This series contains the publicity files for the Engineering, Science, and Management War Training Program at the University of Toledo. The ESMWT was established during World War II to train workers in Toledo industry in specialized subjects such as welding, design, physics, electronics, etc., to assist in the war effort. The material is arranged chronologically.

The publicity files consist of pamphlets, posters, cards, and newspaper clippings dealing with the program. Also included are studies of workers who came to the university, pertaining to why the workers entered the UT program.
