FOR RELEASE UPON RECEIPT

Ground-breaking ceremonies for a \$369,348 addition to the Student Union building at The University of Toledo will be held at noon on Thursday (May 11). The addition will add space for some 400 additional students in the ground level snack-bar area, and a large, multi-purpose room and a browsing room on the second level.

Participating in the ground-breaking ceremonies will be Kay Ingman, a TU senior, who served as president of the Student Union Board when plans for the addition were made. She and Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, will speak at the program, which will be followed by a reception in the Student Union.

The addition is expected to be completed by February, 1968. A \$2.75 million major addition to the Student Union is expected to be under construction by December, 1967.
