Discovery magazine was a publication of the UT College of Law. It began as a student newsletter. However in the early 1970's it became a semi-professional, scholarly journal with articles by state and national figures in the law field. Each issue was focused on a single topic. In 1978, the Student Activities Committee denied Discovery funding on the grounds that it did not serve UT students. Without money, the magazines was forced to fold.

Series contains correspondence, form letters, manuscripts, photos, and newspaper articles relating to the various topics covered in issues of Discovery.
