CAMP ROBERTS

JAN. 20, 1945.

Hello Everyone.

Not doing anything just now so thought I'd write a line or two. I got a letter from you today.

You asked about my teeth and there all healed up now. Just got through writing to Guy. I got a letter from ~~you~~ him yesterday. It got here in 2 days.

When does Milton have to go or has he already went. Hows come Harry didn't get out of it some way.

Is there still plenty of snow there or has it went away so that you can get around now. How low has the

temperature been so far.

I guess we have mortar all week next week. We have a 20 mile speed march wed. I haven't seen Bob for quite a while now. They worked all day to-day but we got off at noon.

I guess there nothing else I can think of now so might as well close. Went to the show this afternoon.
