Phyllis Catlan is to be responsible for ordering council stationery.

A work schedule was devised providing for each member to work in the council office two hours a week.

The positions for Jr. Men's Rep. to Council and Sr. Men's Rep. are reported vacant. Miss Roulet read a letter from James Smith, Vice-President of McKinnon Hall which suggested Larry Muttart for the position of Jr. Rep. A special meeting was called for Monday, October 18, for the discussion of this matter.

Miss Roulet gave a report of the Ohio War Convention held in Columbus, Ohio, June, 1943. This lead to a discussion on money drives. No definite stands were taken.

Names for appointments to Student-Faculty Committees are to be given to Miss Roulet.

Mr. Bergman is in charge of distributing door and file keys to all council members.
