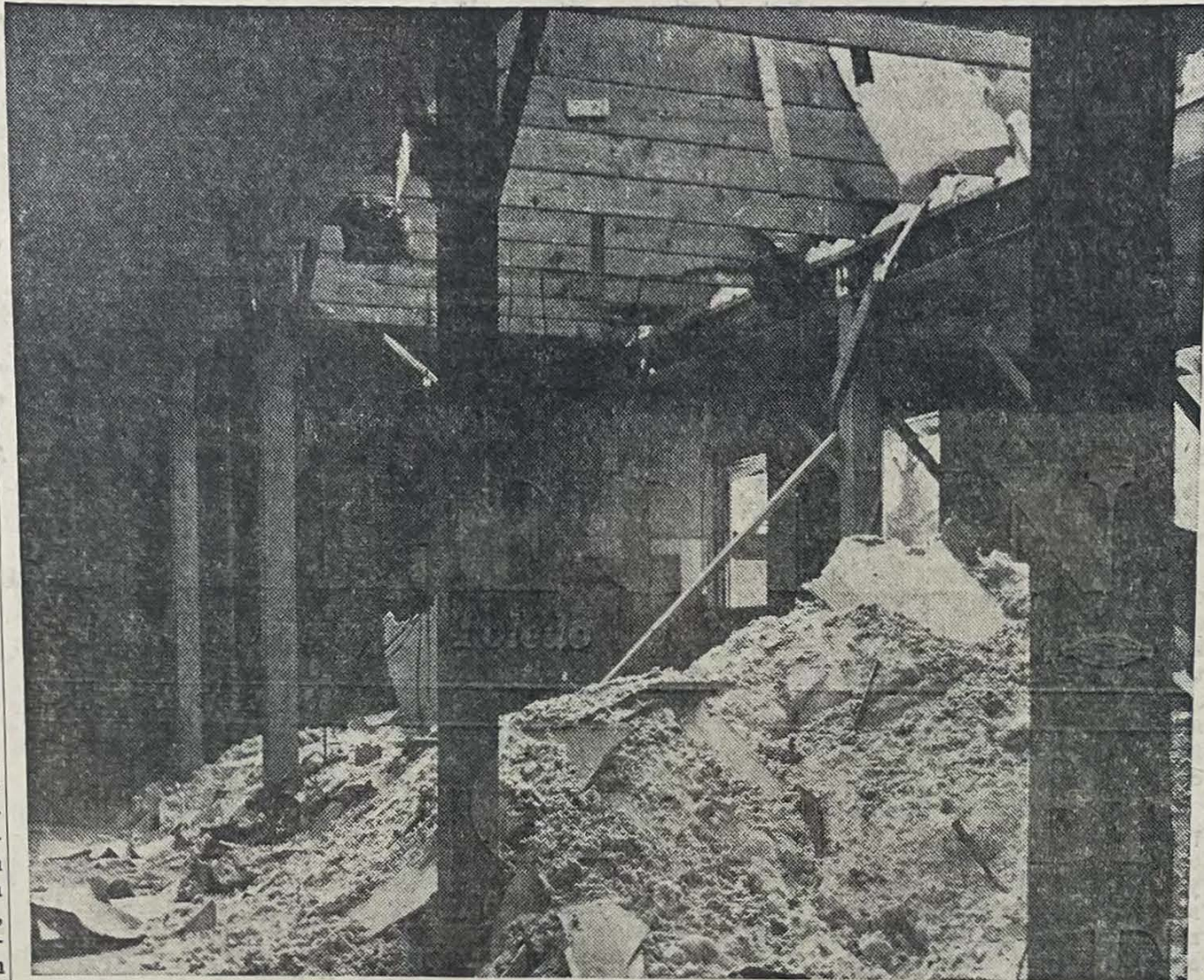


Union Ground Breaking Scheduled For Feb. 26
