CHOICE OF PROFESSOR RAY-
MOND OF CHICAGO FIRST
STEP IN DEVELOPMENT.

An effort will be made by the directors of the Toledo university to develop an institution of learning and higher education that will make a name for Toledo in the field of education.

With this end in view they have secured Professor Jerome H. Raymond to be the first president of the university. Professor Raymond has severed his connection with the University of Chicago and will come at once to organize the Toledo institution.

Both he and Mrs. Raymond have had wide experience in university work, having been connected with the Universities of Wisconsin, Kansas, Chicago and West Virginia. Professor Raymond was president of the latter institution and helped to organize it.
