

# Jacobs to step down in 2015

University of Toledo President Lloyd Jacobs announced March 21 that he will step down on June 30, 2015.

“My time in Toledo has been among the most personally rewarding years of my life, and

Ola and I are looking forward to many more at UT and in the community,” Jacobs, 72, said in a press release. “I’m excited by a new opportunity to help UT and other universities adapt to the financial and resource pressures that will grow only more challenging over time.”

Joseph Zerbey, chair of the UT

Board of Trustees, said Jacobs’ departure is a “mutually agreed decision between Dr. Jacobs and the board of trustees.”

Jacobs’ contract was to run through June 30, 2016, meaning that the president will leave one year before his contract ends.
