of the five-volume "Enciclopedia de la Cultura Espanola," a set of reference works on Spanish culture, to The University of Toledo (Ohio) Library collections.

The volumes were presented to Patrick Barkey, director of University libraries at The University of Toledo, by John W. Potter, presiding judge of the Sixth District Court of Appeals and chairman of the Toledo, Ohio-based Committee on Relations with Toledo, Spain, and by Dr. Arthur R. Steele, professor of history at UT and a member of the committee.

The Spanish language encyclopedia is the gift of Dr. Pedro Ridruejo-Alonso, rector the Centro Universitario de Toledo, and was returned to Toledo, Ohio by Mr. and Mrs. Robert J. Barber (27024 West River Rd., Perrysburg) at the conclusion of their trip to Toledo, Spain with a group of committee members. Judge Potter and Mr. Barber are alumni of The University of Toledo (Potter, B.A., '40; Barber, B.S., '28, M.A., '36), and Mr. Barber is a former instructor in political science at the University. Mrs. Barber, vice chairman of the Committee on Relations with Toledo, Spain, once taught Spanish at the University.
