Dear Mom + All,

May 12, 1945

I am fine and hope this letter  
finds you all the same. I got  
fine letters from you yesterday  
and one from Guy + Eileen.  
I've written quite a few letters  
today. Eileen said that her and  
Guy weren't writing anymore  
and that she felt awful bad  
about it but she said she  
supposed it was to be that  
way.

How is the weather here  
by this time. Is it any better  
than it was. It isn't so bad  
here. I think I told you that  
I'm still with Bob. I got your  
letter that said that Dick Hill  
and Miss Hoerner was married

and then last nite when we  
were at the show I asked him  
about it. He said that one of  
the Keebler boys was killed or  
missing or something and I dont  
believe I got any letters from  
you that said anything about  
it. I'm glad the box got there  
okay. I was afraid it would  
be all smashed up or some-  
thing. How are your neighbors  
or havent you got to know  
them very well yet.

way
