Today the 1st Battalion moved through
me + I just missed seeing Wynne by about
5 minutes. We haven't received any mail
for the last few days so now
we had ought to get it all at once.

We were paid today but I left mine
on the books back 90. How many
bonds have I got altogether.

We each got 1/4 of a loaf of bread
last night the first for quite some
time.

Were between ^{north of} Honomoneo [&] ^{south} Chumbea. The
Chinks are leaving a lot of equipment +
~~ammunition~~ behind then going north so fast
they leave a few snipers behind to slow
us down but it don't do them much good.
Enclosing a propaganda sheet the U.S.
planes drop over the Chink lines. The other
day they had a radio broadcasting to the U.S.
Clark got a bank of shrapnel in the face the
15th but he is all right + came right back with us. Will there
to close now. So long tea
