Jan. 9, 1945

Hello Everyone.

Didn't have time to write you a letter yesterday so sent you a card. I thought I'd start this letter this morning before our class starts, and then I can finish it when we get off at noon. We are studying machine guns now and we stay right in the barracks.

You asked in your letter about that school. They haven't said anything about it since we moved to these barracks. I guess there

isn't any time for it. You asked
about Bob and Helen and there
not very far apart, so I suppose
he can go ~~see~~ here about any
time that he is off. What was
wrong with Trxie. Did it get too
cold for her. There was a little
dog in our barrack last night
I guess I'll have to bring it
home with ~~me~~ ^{me}.

There was another guy who went
home on an emergency pass

yesterday. When he get back
he will have to transferred
and take his training all over.
He was from Ohio. I don't know
whether I told you or not, but
I got a letter from Guy the
other day and it only took about
10 days to get here.

How is everyone and how does
Grandad like the cold weather.
Has Susie growned ~~—~~ ~~∅~~ very
much more. Would like to have

a picture of here if it not to
cold out to take one. Does she
clean up on Jerry yet or can't
she handle him. Does Peggy and
Bub still fight like they did or
does Jerry and Susie do all the
fighting now.

I was to the dental clinic and
had my stitches took out yesterday.
I couldn't even feel them when
they came out, have to close
for now
