

Camp Roberts  
Feb. 4, 1945

Hells Everyone,  
Had a letter from you yesterday <sup>Sunday</sup>  
thought I'd try to think of something  
to write. Glad the pillow top got to  
you okay. Haven't saw Bob and Helen  
for quite a while because I haven't  
hardly had time to get over there. You  
say some of the guys have to go Tues.  
What are they going into the army or  
the Navy. You asked if I had plenty  
of money and I have.

Some of us guys went into Pass  
Robles last nite and its a pretty good  
sized town. We were over to the  
U.S.O. center, and <sup>then</sup> got some things  
to eat in San Miguel when we

were on our way back. We went  
in a cab. Paso Robles is about 18 miles  
and San Miguel is just outside of Camp,  
4 or 5 miles.

Had a letter from Guy ~~yesterday~~ <sup>Friday</sup> and  
one from Betty yesterday. Had K.P. yester-  
day but got off early. We had a night  
problem Fri. nite and didn't get to bed  
until about 10'clock.

It finally stopped raining and it is  
real nice out again today. It did rain  
for about 4 days straight this week.

Will have to quite for now. Have  
to write some more letters yet.
