

Feb. 25, 1945

Hello Everyone,

Sunday.
Got another box from you yesterday and thanks a lot for it. It is all gone now except for the candy I'm saving to eat the rest of the time we're out here. We are here in our new area now and spent most of yesterday putting up the tents and getting the place straightened up. We are going to stay here until Friday night, and then move out at 12:00 and get into camp about 7:30 Saturday

morning. We have to get up Tues.
morning and work until wed. morn.
They are going to feed us 3 rations
them two days. They haven't been
feeding us to much out here but I
suppose its enuff.

Had a letter from you yester
day. Have you been hearing from
Guy and Tom very often. Where is
Tom at, is he still in Belgium
or has he moved again.

Well we only have about 4 or
5 more rations to sleep out here, so

thats not so bad. We keep pretty
warm during the site but when we
get up we about freeze. It doesnt
start getting cold until about 12
at site and then it stays cold
until around 10-10:30 in the fore
noon. It is real nice out now and
is pretty warm. How is the weather
there, has it stopped snowing yet.
Well I guess thats all for now.
cant think of anymore to write
this time
