Dear Mom + Cole,

I thought I'd drop you a line to-day and see how you were all coming. I am okay and hope your all the same. Every thing here is about the same as it was. I haven't received any mail for a long time. I suppose it will take quite a while for it to catch up with me. I didn't get any mail with my last address yet.

How are Guy and Tom coming along. They were talking about bringing the guys in Europe over here. Does Tom think that he will have to come right away or will he stay there for a while longer. Did Charlie Patton have to go to the Army. It seems as though he did. If he did what Camp is he in. Albert Patton had ought to be finished with his training by now. I suppose he will be coming over before long. Have they heard from Bob yet. I think that he went to the 24th, but I might be wrong. I didn't get to much of a chance to talk to him before he left. I am not with any of the guys that I were with in Camp. I was separated from all of them, but there are some other one here that came over the same time I did. Will close for this time.
