Dear Mom + All, Wed. nite  
 Thought I would drop you  
 a few lines again to nite.  
 I have been on guard at the  
 millage all day. I received 4  
 letters and that small package  
 with the gum + candy in it  
 to day. He made pretty good  
 time in getting here. Received  
 two Sunday Times also. The  
 little I got to was dated  
 Aug 31st step up but was  
 you said one of  
 them something about some  
 of the 31st land in Japan.

I hadn't heard anything  
about. It is probably a different

different regiment. You wanted  
to know <sup>before</sup> the 31<sup>st</sup>  
and I am. You can tell what  
division by the H.P.O. Bob is  
in the 24<sup>th</sup>. There was a rumor

going around here that we were  
going to the island of Jark, but  
there are so many rumors

that you don't know what to  
believe. I haven't heard from

Ray or Bob for quite a while  
now. In your letter written  
Aug 25 you said you expected

to go to the States in 30

I suppose he will  
be home before long.  
Does he know yet if he has  
to come over here. Sure hope  
he doesn't. They said anyone  
I believe it was wouldn't have  
to come over here. Some should  
have that many I would think  
what Lloyd doing. Is he  
on his way home to  
Guess I'll close for tonight.  
Finish writing in the morning  
we don't have any lights  
except candles here.

Thurs. morning Sept. 13.

well this is Thurs. morning  
and they are getting ready

to take some more prisoners  
out. I do not have to work  
to-day but will again tomorrow.  
We had a pretty hard rain

last night. We needed it because  
it hadn't rained for a couple  
days. We have to catch all our  
bath water off of the tents.

Think it close for this  
time. Have a couple more

letters to write yet. So long for now
