I thought I would drop you a few lines again to-day. I didnt have to go on guard today. We were issued field jackets and they said something about us getting wool clothes so suppose we will be going to Japan or maybe China. I dont think we will be here but a few days yet and then we will probably move back to the beach.

I am sending a couple rings in this letter. Maybe Peggy can wear them. They are pretty small. I got my watch back but he couldn't fix it. Its stopped running last.
