Sept. 21/1945.

Dear Mom + All.

Thought I would drop you a few lines again to-day. Received a letter from Herbert yesterday. That was the first I had heard from him for a long time. Have you heard from Guy lately. I haven't heard from him or Bob either one. They must be moving or something. They say this division is supposed to go home in Nov. + everyone with under 60 points will go to some other outfit. To day is Sunday and they said we would leave this place Tues. + us guys would transfer in a short time after we got back to the beach.

What is Tom doing now. When
does he think he will get
to come home. I figure on
being home by Christmas "46,"
or maybe a little before
that.

We haven't been getting
any prisoners in the last few
days. I guess they must be about
all in by now. They said
something about there was about
2,000 litter cases out there that
would have to be brought
in.

Think I'll have to close for
now. So long for this time
