Thought I would drop you a few lines again to nite. We had mail call to day but there wasn't much + I didn't get any. Well I still am not transferred. I don't believe it will be long though. There's what I keep thinking but nothing ever happens. Suppose Guy is in Japan now. I guess Bob is on his way to. I wished now that I would have went to the beach and tried to find him. How is Herbert getting along now. Is he still working + going to school to. I haven't least heard from him for quite a while now. I guess he must be too busy or something. Haven't heard

I didn't go to the show tonite.
