I got here. Suppose it will be
slow getting here for a while
now. No body has been getting

any here.

I can't think of any thing to write. Nothing ever happens around here. I believe I told you about the Jap subs that come in the other day. There were five of them.

M-battery has moved to Jaloma to take over the M.P.S. B battery is on stockade guard. I have all moving out so suppose we will be moving to. I was down past the stockade to-day and it sure is a big place. It looks like a city or something.

Well I guess I'll close for this time. Will try to write more later.
