Dear Mom + All

Davao.

Received three letters from you yesterday so thought I would drop you a few lines. You asked if I had ever heard of bloody flux + I haven't. I think I told you that I got another Jones. It was Oct. 7th so it didn't take long to get here. I haven't got any Presses for quite a while now.

We have been getting good eats here. I guess most of the troops have moved off the island so we get more now. We have fresh meat every day, sometimes twice. I don't like the chicken they have. It's not like fresh chicken. It's been froze to long,

I still havent heard from
Guy or Bob. I suppose there pretty
busy if there both moving.

How are the football games
coming. Has Herbert ever played
in any yet. Does he still work
& go to school to.

We have five guys in this
tent. One of them a cook.
He is 19 & from Peoria, Ill.
He took his training at Camp
Roberts to.
