Your interest and concern is appreciated.

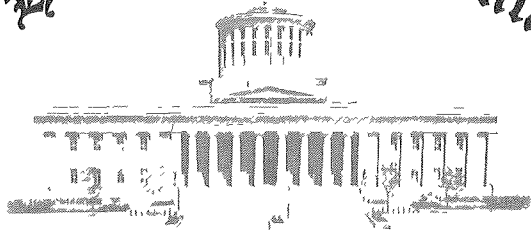
