At our regular meeting held May 18, 1937 we received a petition from the receiving department signed by six employees, the body of which was as follows:-

"We understand that the production department ratings are 2-10¢ per hour more than we are receiving. In regards to length of service men who were hired recently are being paid more than men in the receiving department, who have one and one-half to three years service. We understand that receiving department duties are classified as unskilled labor, but we feel our duties are as exacting and important as labor in the production department. We are requesting that some consideration be given to a reclassification of rates."

The Toledo Works Council after some consideration decided that these men were justified in their complaint, and felt that some consideration should be given these men toward a satisfactory settlement.
