Mr. Saunders being the sole support of a wife and a three year old son, and having no other source of income other than his past position with the Du Pont Company, Toledo Plant, will experience a grave difficulty in even completing his course which should take about six months unless we can find employment for him which he is physically able to do.

I understand that the du Pont Co., has completed their obligation to this man since he has been employed by them a little over four years, but I am appealing to you to see if some unusual course cannot be taken to help this man out of his very unfortunate circumstances.
