When we discussed Mr. Whatsel's case in Toledo on May 9, I understood you to say the promotion procedure is for three foremen to make recommendations to supervision and selection is then made. You added that, to your knowledge, only one person was promoted on seniority alone.

After pointing out that Mr. Whatsel had probably lost position to his detriment by reason of his military service, it was suggested we hold a meeting with management to see if some adjustment could not be made in Mr. Whatsel's favor. I stated I expected to be in Toledo soon again and agreed to advise you so a meeting could be set up.
