MEMO RE. TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH KARL O. MANN OF BUSINESS COLLEGE:
(March 4, 1965)

1. Mann expressed great interest in the proposed Labor Institute, saying that he had tried a year or two ago to get a program similar, but focused more on industrial relations than history.
2. Mann himself received his Ph.D from the Cornell School of Industrial and Labor Relations.
3. He has some contact with local labor officials and has a list of all the unions in Toledo which he would be willing to lend.
4. He also receives copies of many labor publications which he indicated a willingness to donate to the proposed center.
5. He has offered his services for the planning and implementation of a Labor Institute at the University of Toledo.
6. He is currently directing at least one master's thesis in the field of labor relations.
