Dear Betty,

I am pleased to inform you that we have (finally) signed the contract with Teachers College Press for your book, Sexism and the War System. I will briefly outline the important terms of the contract.

You are required to finish the manuscript, including the footnotes, bibliography, foreword, etc, by May 30th. Of course, if you could complete these sections by the end of this month, it would be of great help in expediting the book.

We have given Teachers College Press a subvention or enabling grant to publish the book of \$2,500, which we delivered today. We have also offered TCP access to our word processor/computer system, since the manuscript is already on a floppy disk.


Royalties provide for 5% of cash receipts on the first 3,000 copies sold, 10% on the next 6,000 copies, and 15% thereafter. As we discussed, the Institute will receive the royalties until we have recouped the \$2,500 subvention, the balance to you.

We will receive 15 free copies of the book and have agreed to purchase 300 copies initially, with a 35% discount off cover price on all copies ordered. (The free copies are yours.)

We are delighted to finally have a completed contract on your book, and I look forward to working with you and Teachers College Press on the production and expanded marketing of the book. Please feel free to continue sending suggestions for the marketing campaign in late 1984.
