

# UT Alumni Will Honor Two With Gold, Blue T Awards

**Author, Businessman To Be Recognized For Their Contributions**

The University of Toledo Alumni Association's highest awards will be presented Tuesday to author Jean Gould, a 1937 UT graduate, and businessman Bernard Solomon, who was graduated in 1962.

Ms. Gould has written 17 biographies of poets. Her most recent work, "American Women Poets, Pioneers of Modern Poetry," was published in 1980. She currently is working on a second volume to be published under the same title.

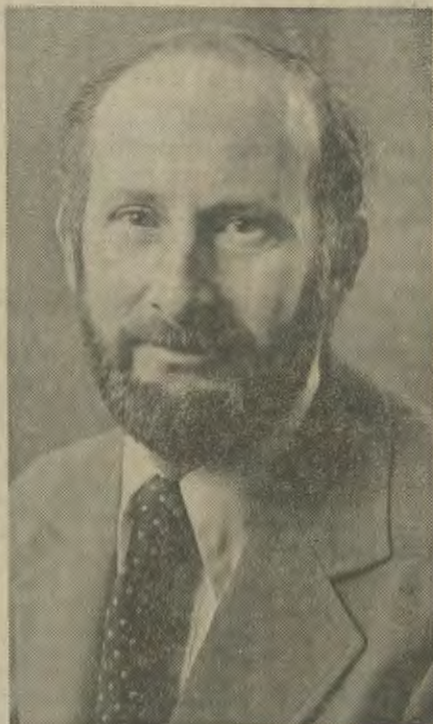
She will receive the Gold T Award in recognition of her loyalty to the university and her distinguished career.

Ms. Gould has donated a number of her manuscripts to the Ward M. Canada Center at UT's Carlson Library and her works are known as the Jean Gould collection.

Mr. Solomon, who was president of the alumni association in 1979-1980, is a life member of the association and a member of the Tower Club. He will receive the Blue T Award for his volunteer work for the university, particularly the hole-in-one tournament, which raises money for scholarships.
