It was moved by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Hahn and carried that the budget as recommended be amended by omitting the itemized classification under salaries and wages.

It was moved by Mr. Hahn, seconded by Mr. Mackenzie and carried that the University Budget as amended be adopted.

It was moved by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Hahn and carried that the re-appointment recommendations of Dr. C. D. Selby, Director of our University Public Health Laboratories and President Stowe, be laid on the table until the next meeting of the Board.

Mr. Johnson left at this time.

On motion made by Mr. Hahn and seconded by Mr. Streetman that the following recommendations of the Committee on University Public Health Laboratories and University Public Service Bureau be adopted as the action of the Board, the vote stood as follows:

1. That the services of Professor Fitzgerald be retained from July 1st to September 15, 1917, at \$225 per month, as a member of the Research staff of the University, and that he be assigned the problem of working out the organization and compilation of such statistics, and graphs as the Bureaus of the Division of Health may require for the proper and scientific presentation of their work to the public.
2. That the Board authorize the creation of the position of extension instructor in Public Hygiene whose duties shall be to investigate matters pertaining to the safeguarding of health and prolonging of life, and to supervise the dissemination of information relating to public health through courses of instruction in the University, through the public schools, through popular lectures and through bulletins and the public press, the salary of such position not to exceed \$150 per month.
3. That the Board authorize the establishment of a Department of Epidemiology in the University Public Health Laboratories, the salary of the Epidemiologist not to exceed \$175 per month.
