Dear Dr. Chandrasekhar,

In your letter of the 28th June, you have sought my approval for your participation in the Conference of the International Union for the Scientific Study of Population in a personal capacity. My Secretary has already spoken to your Secretary about this.

I understand that a very large number of experts have been invited from India to participate in the Conference which is entirely non-governmental. In these circumstances, it would be inappropriate for the expenditure involved in your visit to be debited to the budget of the Ministry of Health.

In another letter of the same date, you had enquired if you could continue to remain an honorary editor of the "Population Review". On the basis of the facts which you have stated in the note enclosed with your letter, I do not see any objection.
