Dear Dr. Chandrasekhar,

Since your letter of October 22nd. enclosing the estimate for the reprint of "My Fight for Birth Control" I have not had very good luck on getting financial assistance to help. Mr. and Mrs. Watumull, who know the printing game pretty well, feel that it is far too much for anyone to pay for the number of copies estimated.

Also as Mrs. Watumull waited for her husband to come from Honolulu before definitely replying to my letter, she thinks that any reliable publisher would not expect you to pay the full amount for editing the book. She also thinks that money should not come from America but should be had in India. I think she discussed this with Lady Rama Rau, and it was the opinion of all that it was far too high a price to make any headway in India. Lady Rama Rau will doubtless be in London on her way to India, perhaps about the 20th. of this month, and you will doubtless see her.

I am returning herewith the two estimates from the Bombay printer, and I apologize for keeping them so long. But I wanted definitely to have an opinion of Mrs. Watumull, as I thought it was just possible that the Watumull Foundation might want to do something in contributing toward the printing of this book. Evidently not.

Enclosed is an amusing account of our episode with the womans club on Lady Rama Rau's visit to Santa Barbara.
