Yours of March 9th regarding this department having an automobile used for towing cars off of the street, such as stolen cars and for parking violations.

I wish to advise you that we have no car used for this purpose. The towing of cars, such as stolen cars, is done by private garage under contract to the Police Department.

However, our traffic ordinance gives us the right to tow a machine off the street for a parking violation. I would call your attention to Section.82-83 and 84 of our ordinance, which covers the parking violations.
