The University of Toledo is undertaking a survey to determine if offices can be closed on Saturdays, President Wilbur W. White has announced.

The proposal would mean a 40-hour work week for non-academic employees who are now on a 41-hour schedule which ends Saturday noon.

Elimination of Saturday classes this fall has reduced the need for non-academic work on that day and administrative officers have been asked to keep records during October to determine whether all offices can be closed or if they should be operated by reduced staffs.

A decision will be made at the end of the month on whether non-academic employees will work an 8-hour five day week or a shorter day plus alternate Saturdays, Dr. White said.
