Three University of Toledo faculty members will be speakers at the Ohio College Association meeting in Columbus on April 21 and 22.

Dr. Frank R. Hickerson will discuss Training in the Artistry of Teaching at the teacher training section, Dr. Duane Smith is chairman of the Ohio Academy of History's panel on the teaching of history in Ohio high schools, and Robert J. Burns, Jr., will participate on a panel for the Adult Education section.

Members of the association's committees include President Wilbur W. White, educational legislation; Dr. Paul Stansbury, graduate study, and Dr. Hickerson, teaching aids.

The meeting, which is the 79th for the association, will close with a session at which Sen. Robert A. Taft and Rep. John McSweeney will be the principal speakers.
