Mailing of 6,000 formal invitations to the inauguration of President Wilbur Wallace White will be completed this week at the University of Toledo, Mrs. Richard E. Gillham, committee chairman, has announced.

The ceremony will be held in the Peristyle of the Toledo Museum of Art at 3 p.m. on May 11.

Several hundred replies have already been received from the mailing to all accredited colleges and universities in the United States.

More than 100 invitations were sent abroad, mostly by air mail, early this month, Mrs. Gillham said. She notes that 15 sent to the Orient were the most costly to have delivered, requiring 50 cents postage each.

Special mailings were sent to universities at which University of Toledo faculty members received their training. There are 107 of these, including 17 in foreign lands. Faculty members also are listed as belonging to 145 different professional and learned societies, each of which has been asked to send a delegate to the inauguration.

Final mailing this week will include many alumni and Toledo area citizens. The inaugural ceremony will be open to the public.
