Advance for May 4 or thereafter

Wilbur Wallace White will be inaugurated as the eighth president of the University of Toledo on May 11 at ceremonies in the Peristyle of the Toledo Museum of Art.

Dr. White, former dean of the Graduate School at Western Reserve University, Cleveland, succeeds the late Philip C. Nash, who died May 6, 1947 after serving as head of the municipal institution since 1933.

The new president is a native of Kansas, received his B.A. degree from The Ohio State University and the M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Chicago. He has been a faculty member at Macalester College, St. Paul, Minn., and at ^{Assiut} Assiut College in Egypt and served in the U.S. State Department's postwar planning division in 1943. He is 44.

Dr. White has specialized in the field of political science and international relations and is the author of four books, most recent being "White's Political Dictionary" published in 1947.

Dr. Raymond Walters, president of the University of Cincinnati, will deliver the inaugural address.
