A conference to encourage outstanding students to enter college and university teaching, sponsored by the Northwestern district of the Ohio College Association, will be held at Bowling Green State University on Saturday, Nov. 19. Invited are students in the eight colleges and universities in this part of the state.

The opening address of the one-day conference will be made by President Asa S. Knowles, University of Toledo. His topic will be, "Needs and Opportunities in the Field of College and University Training."

A panel discussion on "How are Effective College Teachers Prepared?" will be held during the morning session. Participating will be Dr. Lloyd L. Ramseyer, president of Bluffton College, chairman; Dr. Howard Brogan, professor of English and chairman of the department, Bowling Green State University; Dr. William Felch, professor of philosophy and psychology, Findlay College; Dr. E.I.F. Williams, professor and chairman of the department of education, Heidelberg College; and Dr. Louis Hough, professor and chairman of the economics department, the University of Toledo.

The afternoon session will begin with a symposium on "Why Be a College Teacher," with Sister Mary Lawrence, dean of Mary Manse College, Toledo, as chairman. Others participating will be Joan Hill, a student at Mary Manse College, speaking on "Why I am Interested in College Teaching"; Dr. Dean Hackett, assistant dean of men, Heidelberg College, "Why I Chose College Teaching"; and Dr. Alton Kurts, professor of education, Defiance College, "Why I Stayed In College Teaching."

"Admission to Graduate School" will be the subject of a talk by Dr. Emerson C. Shuck, dean of the College of Liberal Arts at Bowling Green State University. The discussion to follow will be led by Dean Frederick Lemke, Heidelberg College.

The committee in charge of the program includes Dr. K.H. McFall, provost, Bowling Green State University, chairman; President F. Bringle McIntosh, Ohio Northern University; President Ramseyer; Dean Lemke; President Knowles; Sister Mary Lawrence, and President Clifford Fox, Findlay College.
