Representatives of the eight northwest Ohio colleges met at the University Tuesday with three members of the Ohio Commission on Education Beyond the High School.

A luncheon in the faculty dining room was followed by a meeting in the office of President Asa S. Knowles, commission member, with Dr. John C. Baker, president of Ohio University commission chairman, and Dr. C.E. Ficken, executive secretary of the commission.

The group discussed expected increase in college enrollments up to 1970, policy of colleges toward area students, plans for expansion of facilities for undergraduate and graduate students and needs for expansion of professional programs, 2-year programs and cooperative programs.

Also on the agenda were admissions policies, problems of procuring faculty members and financing for the years ahead.

Recommendations will be drafted for presentation to the commission.
