Twenty-seven University of Toledo authors -- including Board member Ward M. Canaday and President William S. Carlson -- are credited with 60 books and articles during 1959, according to a recent report from the University Library.

Mr. Canaday's article, "Man's Third Epoch; Intimations at Geneva of the Imminence of the Atomic Age" appeared in the Dec. 13, 1958 issue of the Harvard Alumni Bulletin. A book review, a biographical sketch of a famous University of Michigan scientist and reprints of two speeches carry the President Carlson's byline.

Several of the publications are on display this month in a case in the hallway connecting University Hall with the Library building.

Subject matter ranges from a book of poetry, "The Labyrinth and Other Poems" by Associate Professor of English Martin Scholten to an article in the Canadian Journal of Chemistry by Dr. Lancelot C.A. Thompson, assistant professor of chemistry, "The Solubility of Uranium Peroxide in Acidic and Basic Media at 25 Degrees Centigrade."
