Blake-More Godwin, vice president and former director of the Toledo Museum of Art, has been selected as honorary member of the year by Phi Kappa Phi, national honor society, for the 10th annual Honors Day at the University of Toledo, Wednesday, May 23. Mr. Godwin was cited for his outstanding service to the community and his scholarly achievement.

Carole A. Wright (2715 Algonquin Parkway) a senior in engineering physics, will be named Phi Kappa Phi scholar of the year, as the senior with the highest academic average. Homer P. Stall, Jr., (18 W. League St., Norwalk), a pre-medical student, will receive the honor society's award as sophomore scholar of the year.

The Honors Day program will begin at 10:45 p.m., with an academic procession from the TU library to Doermann Theater, where recipients of more than 80 prizes and awards will be announced, and new members of TU's honor societies will be presented.

Following the ceremonies in Doermann Theater, the annual ROTC review will be conducted in front of University Hall. Military awards will be presented at that time. TU President William S. Carlson and Lt. Col. Arthur J. DeLuca will review the ROTC cadets.

TU's Student Senate will sponsor an Honors Day tea from 3 to 5 p.m. in the Student Union Lounge in recognition of the award winners and honor society initiates.
