Four honorary degrees will be awarded at the University of Toledo Commencement on June 7, it was announced today by President William S. Carlson. Recipients are Harry E. Collin, Lev Flournoy, Sr., and George W. Ritter, all of Toledo, and G. Ernst Giesecke of Chicago.

Dr. G. Ernst Giesecke is professor of higher education and associate dean of the Graduate School of Education, University of Chicago. A native of Texas, he has been assistant dean of the Galesburg Division of the University of Illinois, dean of Arts and Sciences at North Dakota Agricultural College and vice president of Texas Technological College.

He has been active in educational affairs and currently is a member of the State Advisory Committee, Illinois Special Study Project for Gifted Children. He is a consultant for the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and as such has worked on academic matters with the administration and faculty of The University of Toledo during the last two years.

Dean Giesecke, who is a skilled musician, received the doctorate from Stanford University, where his thesis was in historical linguistics with a major in German and minor in Latin.
