Summer Commencement at the University of Toledo will be held Sunday, August 25 at 3 p.m. in TU's Doermann Theater. A total of 194 persons will be candidates for 62 masters' degrees, 125 bachelors' degrees and 6 two-year, associate degrees.

Of the 62 receiving the master's degree, 37 -- more than half -- received their undergraduate degrees from other colleges and universities.

Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, will deliver the charge to the graduates, and Mayor John Potter, a member of the TU class of 1940, will administer the service pledge.

Immediately following the ceremonies, a President's reception will be held in TU's Student Union for the graduates, their families, and guests.

The summer graduates bring to more than 844 the total number of persons receiving degrees from TU this year. In June, some 650 persons were graduated. The total is considerably higher than for 1962, when only one Commencement, in June, was held. In previous years, students who expected to complete their degree requirements during the summer were permitted to participate in the June Commencement.

More than half of the degrees are in education, with 40 masters' degrees and 56 bachelors' degrees to be awarded.

Dr. James O. McDonald, pastor of Covenant United Presbyterian Church, will give the Invocation and the Benediction.
