A program marking the opening of the Day Law School at the University of Toledo and to introduce its new dean will be held Monday (September 16) at 3:30 p.m. in TU's Moot Court Room. Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, will introduce the new dean, Dr. Karl Krastin.

Dr. Krastin, a native of Toledo, received the BA degree from Western Reserve University and the LLB from its law school. He received the Doctor of Juridical Science degree from the Yale University School of Law. Prior to his appointment, Dr. Krastin was professor of law at the University of Florida.

The Day Law School, for which classes are being offered for the first time this fall, is expected to have a first year enrollment of about 35 students. Enrollment in the Evening Division is expected to continue at present levels, including an entering class of approximately 45 students.

Speakers at the Monday program include Jules D. Lippmann, president of TU's board of directors; Municipal Court Judge George Kiroff; and John Overman, president of TU's law alumni association.

John Stoepler, assistant professor of law, is chairman of the program.
