The University of Toledo has announced formation of a Campus Committee for State Issue Number 1, with Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, serving as general chairman. Jesse R. Long, TU provost, and Willard W. Smith, TU's director of administration, were appointed coordinators.

Others appointed to the campus committee are: Professors Edward Garrison and Norman Blume, student supervision; Jerry L. Morrow, speakers' bureau and publicity; Edward Schmakel, alumni coordinator; Professor George Taoka, faculty coordinator; Mrs. Arthur L. Black, president of the University Women's Club, women's division; and Jeff Robinson, president of Student Senate, Shelia O'Leary, president of Peppers, and Joe Blumberg, president of Blue Key, as student chairmen.

The committee will help coordinate campus activities with those of the state-wide committee of Citizen's For Ohio's Future, which is promoting State Issue Number 1. The proposed issue would provide \$250 million, \$175 million of which is earmarked for public higher education.
