The University of Toledo Reserve Officers Training Corps program will mark a milestone on July 30 when the 499th and 500th TU cadets are commissioned Army 2nd Lieutenants. The first cadet to receive an Army commission through TU's ROTC program was Robert F. Beltz, who received his 2nd lieutenant's bars on June 16, 1949.

David S. Hardin, 2256 Glenwood Ave., will be the 499th TU cadet to receive a commission. He was graduated in June from TU's College of Engineering. He'll enter active duty in July, 1965.

The 500th commission will go to Robert S. Hardy, Jr., 322 Crittenden St. He is a graduate of TU's College of Education, where he majored in physical education. He will enter active duty on August 27.

Commissioning ceremonies will be conducted by Colonel Arthur J. DeLuca, commander of TU's ROTC detachment, in the office of Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, at 10 a. m. on Thursday (July 30).
