Among the 222 persons who received degrees at today's (Sunday, Aug. 30, 1964) commencement at the University of Toledo were graduates of 39 other colleges and universities. Of the 91 persons receiving graduate degrees (2 doctorates, 89 master's), 61 had earlier received degrees from other schools.

Bowling Green State University led the list, having conferred seven degrees earlier on the TU graduates. Next was Ohio State University with five alumni in the TU graduating class. Then follow: University of Michigan (3), University of Richmond (3), Ashland College (3), Wayne State University (2), Ohio Northern University (2), Kent State University (2), Defiance College (2), and one each from Wheaton College, University of Massachusetts, Columbia University, Wittenberg College, John Carroll University, Ohio University, Fairfield University, Asbury College, Valparaiso University, Loras College, University of Buffalo, Case Institute of Technology, University of Chicago, Capital University, Mt. Union College, Mary Baldwin College, Heidelberg College, Bluffton, Minot (N. Dakota) State Teachers College, Adrian College, Potsdam (New York) State University Teachers College, Wesleyan University, Virginia State College, St. Olaf College, Western Reserve University and General Motors Institute.
