The 600th anniversary of the Jagiellonian University of Krakow, Poland, will be observed at The University of Toledo on Sunday, November 8.

Sponsored by the Polish Arts Club of Toledo, the public meeting will be at 3 p. m. in Doermann Theater. Principal speaker will be the Hon. Thaddeus Machrowicz, federal court judge of Detroit.

Dr. Janina Adamczyk, professor of sociology at TU and general chairman of the program, will give a brief history of the Jagiellonian University, oldest institution of higher learning in Poland and second only to the University of Prague in all central Europe.

Other speakers will be Mrs. Eugenia Czerwinska, president of the sponsoring club; Thaddeus Walinski, vice mayor of Toledo; Dr. William S. Carlson, president of The University of Toledo; Dr. Boris Nelson, professor of humanities at TU, and the Very Rev. W. Czajkowski.

Musical selections will be given by Ruth M. Lambertus, pianist and assistant professor of music at TU; Mary Ann Wojciechowski, pianist; and Richard Kozbial, baritone.

Lee J. Robie will be master of ceremonies.
